

Summer of Applied Geophysical Experience (SAGE) 25th Anniversary

June 18 – July 13, 2007 (U.S. Undergraduates)
June 21 – July 12, 2007 (Core Program)
Santa Fe, New Mexico

The Los Alamos branch of the Institute of Geophysics and Planetary Physics (IGPP) is again sponsoring SAGE, the Summer of Applied Geophysical Experience, for 2007. The SAGE program is a three-week graduate and advanced undergraduate course of instruction and research in exploration geophysics. For further details and a description of the program, please refer to the SAGE web site at www.sage.lanl.gov. The **Core** program for all participants will operate from Thursday, June 21 (arrival on Wednesday, June 20) through Thursday, July 12, 2007. The cost will be \$450, of which \$100 is due with the application.

Continued support from the National Science Foundation will again allow us to extend SAGE to four weeks for “undergraduate” students who are U.S. citizens or permanent residents. The term “undergraduate” *includes students who graduated in the spring of 2007*. For U.S. undergraduates, SAGE will begin on Monday, June 18 (arrival on Sunday, June 17) and will be extended through 1:00 p.m. Friday, July 13, 2007. Stipend and travel support will be automatic, if accepted, and the \$450 fee will be waived.

We welcome applications from students in your department. **Please note that the deadline for SAGE 2007 is March 30.** Students should have a quantitative background and some introduction to geophysics, though they need not be geophysics majors. For example, a minimum of one year (two semesters or three quarters) of physics (through Electricity and Magnetism), and three semesters of calculus (four preferred) are required. Structural geology and introductory geophysics are recommended, but not required. We particularly welcome math/physics majors and other students who are considering careers in geophysics.

By way of application, we require a letter of interest, two faculty references, proof of medical insurance, and complete transcripts. See the SAGE web site for application and reference forms.
